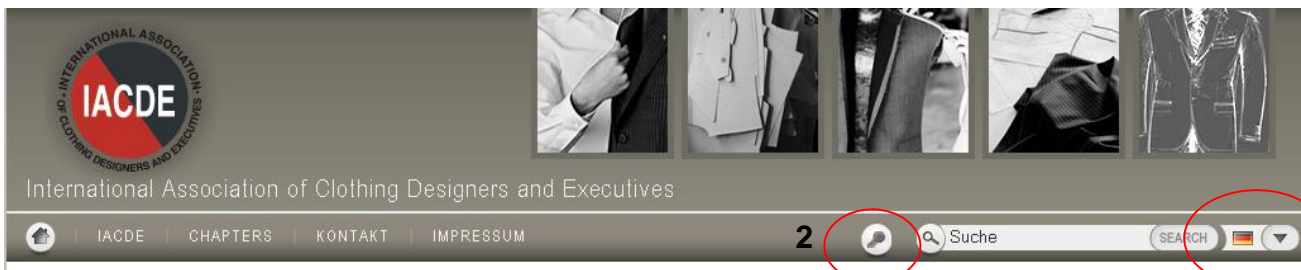




## Quick Start handout of the IACDE Homepage

The new Website of the IACDE is available in 5 languages of which English, German and Italian is already finished. The Chinese and Japanese version is still in progress and will be finished in 2011. The basic homepage has several parts of information spaces. On the top and the left side you find the Overview and Explorer which shows you where you are. The login (2) and language selection (3) buttons you find on the top right of the menu bar. In addition there is a search function available to look for particular content on the various pages.



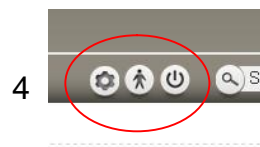

To login you click on the key (2), then you enter your name and password that is programmed for you. If you are for the first time on the Website the login data will be your first and last name like [a.sample](#) and the password is the full first name [anton](#). After the first login we recommend to go directly to the profile section to verify your correct address and email data and to change the password as you like it. You find your profile after logging in by clicking on the person (4) on the right top bar. For logout you press the button next to the person (4)

Once you have logged in you are able to browse where you want to by just moving the mouse over the buttons. After that another menu opens where you click on the topic you are interested in. If you “get lost” and want to get back you simply click on the small house (1) on the top left of the menu bar.

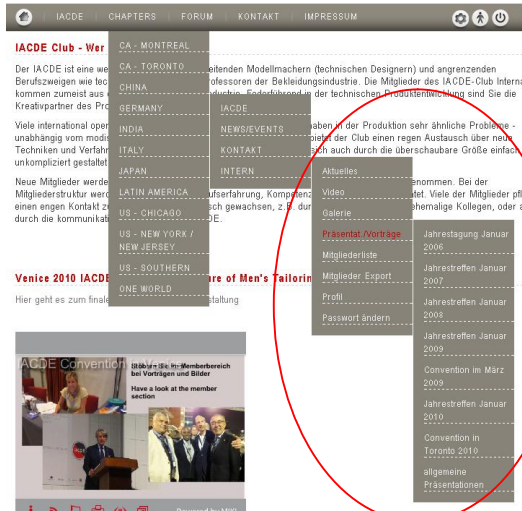

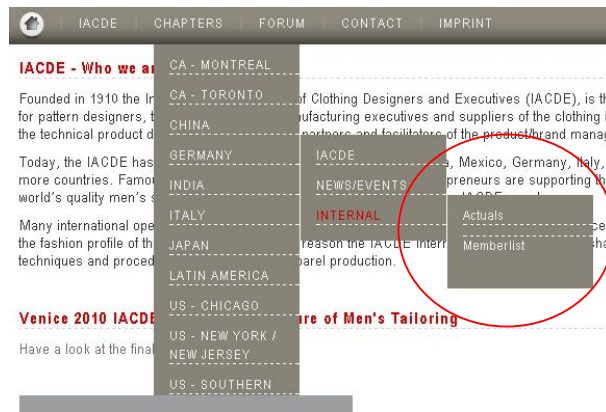

German version

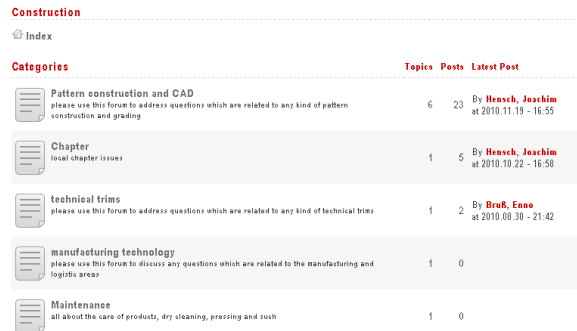


English version

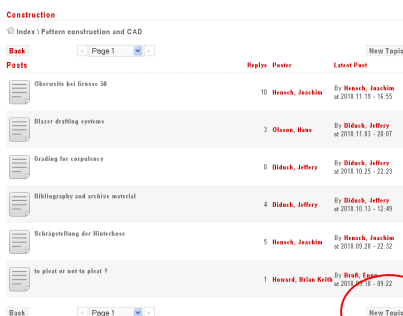

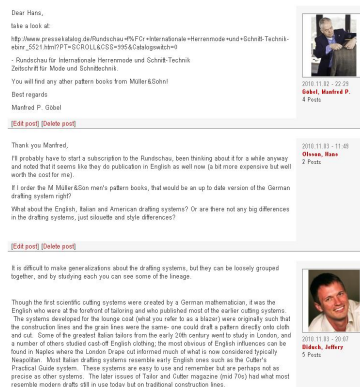
